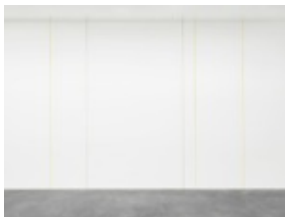

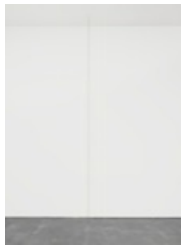
Untitled (Seven-part Vertical Construction), 1987

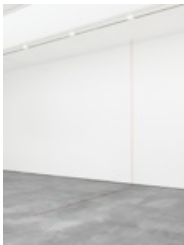
Untitled (Four-part Vertical Construction), 1987
